FULLY INVOLVED 3 STOREY HOUSE WITH HEAVY SMOKE AND FLAMES SHOWING FROM THE 2ND FLOOR/ROOF OF CHARLIE/DELTA. CREWS FOUND THE ENTIRE CHARLIE SIDE (ALL 3 FLOORS) INVOLVED IN FIRE WITH THE SIDING ALREADY BURNED OFF A LARGE PORTION OF THE HOUSE. CONFIRMED THIS WAS A DEFENSIVE OPERATION AND ORDERED 2 1/2' LINE TO BE USED ALPHA SIDE TRYING TO SLOW FIRE SPREAD TO ALPHA.
