**Re: Request under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act***

British Columbia Ferry Services Inc. (BC Ferries) received your request for access to records under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the FOIPP Act) on August 19, 2016. Your request seeks the following:

*"Copies of the surveys done to ascertain the levels of radiation on the BC Ferries does not exceed the levels of SC6 [Safety Code 6] when passengers are on board."*

We have not identified any records responsive to your request.

BC Ferries is committed to protecting the safety of its customers. Radiofrequency communications equipment, including that which BC Ferries uses, is federally regulated by Industry Canada and must meet applicable exposure limits set by Health Canada (Safety Code 6).


