Dear Mr and Mrs Noble,

If the question is asked in the context of EMF hypersensitivity, then I would refer you to the WHO statement which in summary states that symptoms are real, but no scientific causal proof on etiology at present links those symptoms to EMF exposures.

If you are referring to the possibility that if RF (as from cellphones) were shown to be carcinogenic, then it would be reasonable to posit that children would be at higher risk from repeated exposures to this source.

Should either of these outcomes be convincingly demonstrated, I and my colleagues in public health would make appropriate recommendations re risk mitigation.
