Martin L. Pall, PhD is a Professor Emeritus of Biochemistry and Basic Medical Sciences in the School of Molecular Biosciences at Washington State University. He is an internationally recognized expert on the science behind 5G. His ground breaking review articles show the mechanism by which human-generated electromagnetic frequencies cause biological and health effects.



**Timothy Schoechle, PhD** is the author of <u>Re-Inventing Wires</u> and is a global expert on wired fiber networks. He sits on several standards committees of the International Standards Organization (ISO) and International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC), and is a life member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE). He is a former faculty member of the University of Colorado,

College of Engineering and Applied Science, and is a Senior Research Fellow, at the National Institute for Science, Law & Public Policy.
