

Annie J. Sasco Annie J. Sasco I was NOT a researcher in the MOBI-KIDS project but I have been the first one to publically ask for the results. The final report has been sent to the European Commission on January 13th, 2017 with no results in there. Just a few sentences including one stating "a publication is in preparation." Since then, nothing. I first requested these results to be made public in September 2018 at the UK Children with Cancer Conference in London at the Church House where I was asked to give the Opening Plenary lecture. My conference was video streamed live at the time of my talk. The only result of my request was that my conference was two hours later taken out and therefore could no longer be seen. The organizers replaced it by the video of my comments at the NTP-NIEHS earlier that year. I was told that I would be accused of diffamation if I kept on requesting the video to be put back. Since then I discuss this problem every time I am talking about the issue of cancer risk linked to EMF and in particular the special case of children. I did it at the Danish Parliament, at the Senate of Rhode Island, at a meeting with "Gilets Jaunes", at various meetings of different kinds in France and in interviews to journalists every time I have a chance. It is totally unethical to say the least, immoral and unacceptable not to have access to these results. The study was funded by the European Commission which means WE as citizens of Europe paid for this through our taxes. The public has to right to know and now with the roll-out of 5G without any preliminary testing on experimental animals IT IS AN EMERGENCY. For those of you who do not know me I am an MD, MPH, SM, DrPH, HDR or an overly graduated physician and a scientist with three degrees from Harvard. I spent all my career and I keep on doing it, "just" tring to prevent cancer whenever something can be done. I spent 22 years at the International Agency for Research on Cancer - World Health Organization (IARC-WHO) where I founded and headed for 9 years the Program then becoming Unit of Epidemiology for Cancer Prevention and also was for two years Acting Chief of the WHO Program for Cancer Control. I am also just like all of us a simple citizen who would like to see her grand-children living in a less polluted world! Annie J. Sasco
