We propose to frame the conversation for the July 24 meeting around several interesting and emerging practice areas where members are becoming actively engaged:

- **Satellites** — The BALANCE GROUP has filed several important challenges to FCC licenses and standard setting and is preparing several other administrative actions. The templates are available to ILAN members who are prepared to implement similar challenges in their home countries. The actions of the FCC will have directly and measurable consequences internationally.
- **Empowering Local Communities** — A corpus of best practices is emerging which can be applied across national borders.
- **Personal Injury Actions** — We are on the threshold of breakthroughs in personal injury actions relating to RFR harms.
- **Workers Compensation** — This is a fertile field. We will discuss recent international precedents.
- **Real Estate Development and Financing** — As uninsured 5G commercial and residential real estate projects come under greater judicial and regulatory scrutiny, just as with asbestos, banks and other financial institutions will wisely require detailed SafeG Compliance plans from borrowers with effective

indemnification provisions in their applications covering RFR contamination.

- **International Human Rights** — We will discuss the recent trend in Europe to criminalize scientific inquiry and concern over the health effects of RFR contamination, especially involving 5G.
- **Collaborative Innovation** — Rebalancing the 5G/AI/IoT/Satellite Juggernaut will occur by fostering breakthrough inventions and innovations through effective collaboration, strategic alliances, and creative international licensing regimes.
