^{*} Information from Scott McCullough: Case law states that the PA state agency in charge of ADA lacks jurisdiction over utility matters, so Public Utility Commission controls. However, the ruling does not preempt the ADA – it can't. The federal statutes would need to be invoked in a venue that can adjudicate the federal disabilities laws. There are the ADA, FHAA and Rehab Act.

^{**} Flower Hill decision: "Most importantly, the Judge ruled that the provisions of the 1996 Act do not necessarily apply to the new uses of wireless to provide broadband and other services.

'Improved capacity and speed are desirable (and, no doubt, profitable) goals in the age of smartphones,' he wrote, 'but they are not protected by the Act.'"

***Erica Rosenberg served as Assistant Chief of the Competition and Infrastructure Policy Division of the FCC's Wireless Bureau for 7 or so years as a NEPA attorney. Erica has worked at various agencies as an environmental policy lawyer (including USEPA) and has worked as Committee staff/counsel (for both the US Senate and House) on public lands issues. Erica has been in academia, teaching public lands and legislation at the law school at Arizona State University. She has been a consultant to a range of environmental NGOs, including, most recently, NRDC (National Resources Defense Council).
